ACTION STEPS:

- First, prayerfully consider your Giving Plan to Hosanna. If you currently give, consider an increase to help fund general expenses and new ministry opportunities. If you do not give consistently, consider making a plan. Make it doable, a dollar a day, \$5 per week, \$25 per month? Try it for three months, giving first, and see what happens!
- Enclosed you will find an Estimate of Giving Plan Card, please return the card by December 31, 2023.



- Our monthly payroll is \$24,200
- Our monthly Thrivent Mortgage is \$9,336
- Our monthly Electric/Gas payment is \$3,500

PLACES to GIVE:

- **General Fund:** This is the FIRST fund to support. This fund pays for all the on-going household expenses such as mortgage, insurance, utilities, staff salaries, maintenance and general repairs, snowplowing... and more!
- Capital Projects Account (CPA)/Building Fund: Giving to this fund is beyond a General Fund gift. This fund is
 used for all needed and necessary capital improvements to our home (building/mission post) such as
 resurfacing the parking lots, security system upgrade, tackling the back wall efflorescence, new carpet when
 and as we need it... and more! Under usual circumstances, this fund also serves as a reserve in the summer if
 giving lapses. Any funds used MUST be paid back by December 31 of the year borrowed.

WAYS to GIVE:

Forms and information can be found at hosannaforestlake.net/giving

- **ACH/Direct Deposit Giving:** This is the BEST way to stay consistent with your giving. Money gets transferred directly from your bank to Hosanna's bank. No service charge incurred.
- Your Bank Bill Pay: Set up Hosanna as a recurring payment (gift!). Typically, no service charge from your bank.
- Online Giving: hosannaforestlake.net use the GIVING tab. There is a bank charge incurred by Hosanna.
- VANCO-Mobile App: Download the app on Apple or Android devices. Search for Hosanna, Forest Lake and follow prompts. There is a bank fee associated.
- Church Envelopes checks or cash: Hosanna can supply you with preprinted weekly giving envelopes. These can be brought to church or sent in the mail (you supply the stamp!). Envelopes serve as a reminder to give consistently. Hosanna is charged for printing and sending this product.
- **Directed giving from retirement or other plans:** Contact your plan administrator or Roxanne Anderson at finance@hosannaforestlake.net. There could be tax advantages for you.
